## Trucking pool at $19.87 \$ / \mathrm{m} 3$ to producer

- Loads containing too much defective wood, including log length, minimum diameter, knots, forks, junk, dead wood, damaged wood by fire or insects, can be refused by "THE PURCHASER" or have a warning imposed. A warning or refusal form will be produced and deliver by" THE PURCHASER" to the supplier and to the concerned carrier.
- Delivered wood will have to be fresh and not exceeding three months between their cut and their delivery, unless there are exceptions agreed between the parties.
- Pile of logs on the truck must have at least one equal side in order to be able to measure the logs length.

Criteria 1: No roots exceeding by more than 10 cm (grade 10) from the main axis of the trunk, will be accepted.
Criteria 2: Shattered end must not exceed $20 \%$ of the diameter at the felling point.
Criteria 3: Defects at the felling point are not tolerated.
Criteria 4: No snags, warmed or burned stalk are tolerated. Logs and stalks must not contain foreign body (sand, nail, etc.)
Criteria 5: Different varieties cannot be mixed except when they are grouped and isolated in the load. A shipment with separated varieties should have as many delivery licences that there are varieties. Tamarack and Basswood must be separated.
Criteria 6: The accept varieties are listed below. All other varieties are considered as foreign varieties.

Yollow Birch

Criteria 7: The minimum tolerated tree stump diameter is: 14 cm (grade 14)
Criteria 8: The fine ends must be topped at: 10 cm (grade 10)
Criteria 9: Tolerated log length $3.20 \mathrm{~m}+/-5 \mathrm{~cm}$. Furthermore, to respect the principle of "fall off" it is tolerated that multiple length between 2.54 m and 3.20 m ( $8^{\prime \prime} 4^{\prime \prime}$ and $10^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}$ ) are included in the load but that the sum of these does not exceed $20 \%$ of the load.
Criteria 10: Stalks must be branch-free at all length. Any forks exceeding 10 cm from base will be refused. They must be cut-off from the main stalk. From the base keep the straighter part flush with bole.
Criteria 11 - Limbs and knots must be cut flush with bole (at the same time as the bole).
Criteria 12 - Chunk must be as straight as possible. When a chunk cannot be straighten by a cut, crooks and sweeps cannot excess of: Chunk of 2.5 m : 12 cm (grade 12)

Chunk of $3.20 \mathrm{~m}: 20 \mathrm{~cm}$
Criteria 13: The accepted maximum diameter is: 70 cm (grade 70)
Criteria 14: Rot must not exceed more than $50 \%$ diameter in private forest. If more than half of the diameter is rotten or has a hole, we cut until the diameter of the rot is less than half of the stalk diameter.

## SAWLOG AND VENEER

- Every producer should negotiate with the buyer and agree on the minimum price, volumes to be delivered, wood specifications and trucking organisation. Be sure to respect buyer's specifications.
- The wood should be correctly piled. Avoid piling under power lines.

## ANNEXE"A"

## QUALITY STANDARDS - HARDWOOD MEASURED BY THE ANHYDROUS METRIC TON

The buyer will only accept commercial hardwood logs suitable for the manufacture of fine, healthy and fresh papers, free of foreign matter and having the following characteristics:

1. The length of the 2.44 meters ( $\mathbf{8}$ feet) logs must be between 1.82 meters ( $\mathbf{6}$ feet) and 2.60 meters ( 8.5 feet). For multi-length wood, the logs must be between 2.44 meters and 4.30 meters ( 14 feet). The recommended method is that of fixed lengths ensuring not to cut too short. Stacks at the transit yard must be distinct according to the length of the logs they contain; either at 2.44 metres or multi-length at 4.30 metres.
2. The minimum diameter at the end, without bark, shall not be less than 7.62 cm ( 3 inches). The minimum diameter corresponds to the actual measurement of the smallest axis of the cut.
3. The maximum diameter at the coarse end should not exceed 66 cm ( 26 inches) under bark without curvature. The maximum diameter corresponds to the actual measurement of the largest axis of the cut. Logs over 66 cm must be cut in 2.44 metres and delivered in separate lashes.
4. Any abnormal branches, knots or growths should be shaved parallel to the outcrop of the trunk of the ball. All logs must be sawed-off at both ends most perpendicular to the axis.
5. The logs must be reasonably straight and must not contain any forks. The shape of the log must allow its passage through a cylinder of 71 cm ( 28 inches) in diameter.
6. The logs must not contain any foreign matter.
7. Fire-damaged wood and/or insects are not accepted and will result in complete refusal of loading. The same will apply to loads containing undesirable species (e.g. cedar, hemlock and other softwoods).
8. The load shall contain only those groups of species described in paragraph 14 of this annex, which form an integral part hereof. No mixing in species groups is permitted.
9. Soft decay (effortlessly penetrable with a pencil tip) shall not exceed 0.5 cubic metres solid per load.
10. Opt-out clause
10.1 Loads containing more than $5 \%$ by solid volume of wood not complying with the standards provided for in paragraphs $1,2,4,8$ and 9 of this Annex may be refused in its entirety by the measurer, including wood affected by any form of decay;
10.2 Loads not complying with paragraphs $3,5,6,7$ or 10 of this Annex shall be refused by the measurer;
10.3 The load shall be in such a way as to allow efficient unloading and the gauge to perform his work, otherwise the load will be refused. The SUPPLIER must comply with the buyer's loading standards; The wood must be loaded longitudinally in relation to the axis of the trailer. The following loading standards apply:
